







#### Population by Age









#### Population by Age




### Traffic Count Map - Close Up

The years of the counts in the database range from 2019 to 1963. Over 60% of the counts were taken between 2010 and 2019 and over 87% of the counts were taken between 2000 and 2019. Traffic counts are identified by the street on which they were recorded, along with the distance and direction to the closest cross-street. Distances displayed as 0.00 miles (due to rounding), are closest to the site. A traffic count is defined as the two-way Average Daily Traffic (ADT) that passes that location.
